Before incorporating aligners into practice, a doctor benefits from understanding the complete clinical workflow, because each stage affects the next. Structured clear aligner training for dentists supports:

- Better case assessment and more realistic treatment objectives

- A working grasp of how teeth actually move under aligner forces

How to Become a ClearPath Certified Provider

Step 2: Understand Aligner Biomechanics

Aligners move teeth through carefully staged force systems. A certified provider should understand how forces are expressed, why movements are staged in sequence, which movements are predictable, and how attachment-assisted movements extend what aligners can achieve. Biomechanics is where clear aligner training moves from theory to clinical reasoning.

Step 3: Develop Case Selection Skills

Case selection is arguably the single biggest determinant of a smooth aligner case. It rests on thorough clinical examination, patient history, quality records, occlusal assessment, an honest read of case complexity and clearly defined treatment objectives. If aligners are not the right fit for a particular patient, a trained provider should be able to say so and explain why. That candour protects patients and builds trust in the practice.

Step 4: Learn Digital Treatment Planning

Modern aligner treatment is planned digitally. Doctors learn to work with digital scans, review virtual setups and treatment simulations, evaluate proposed tooth movements stage by stage, and communicate revisions with the treatment planning team.
